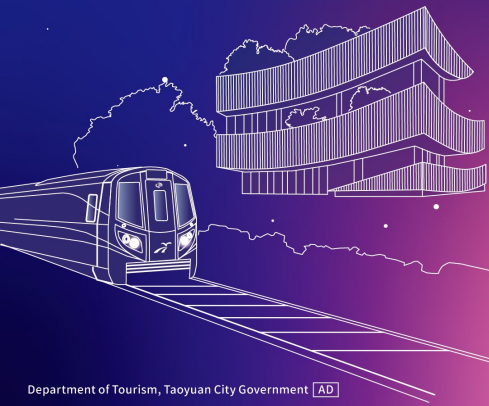


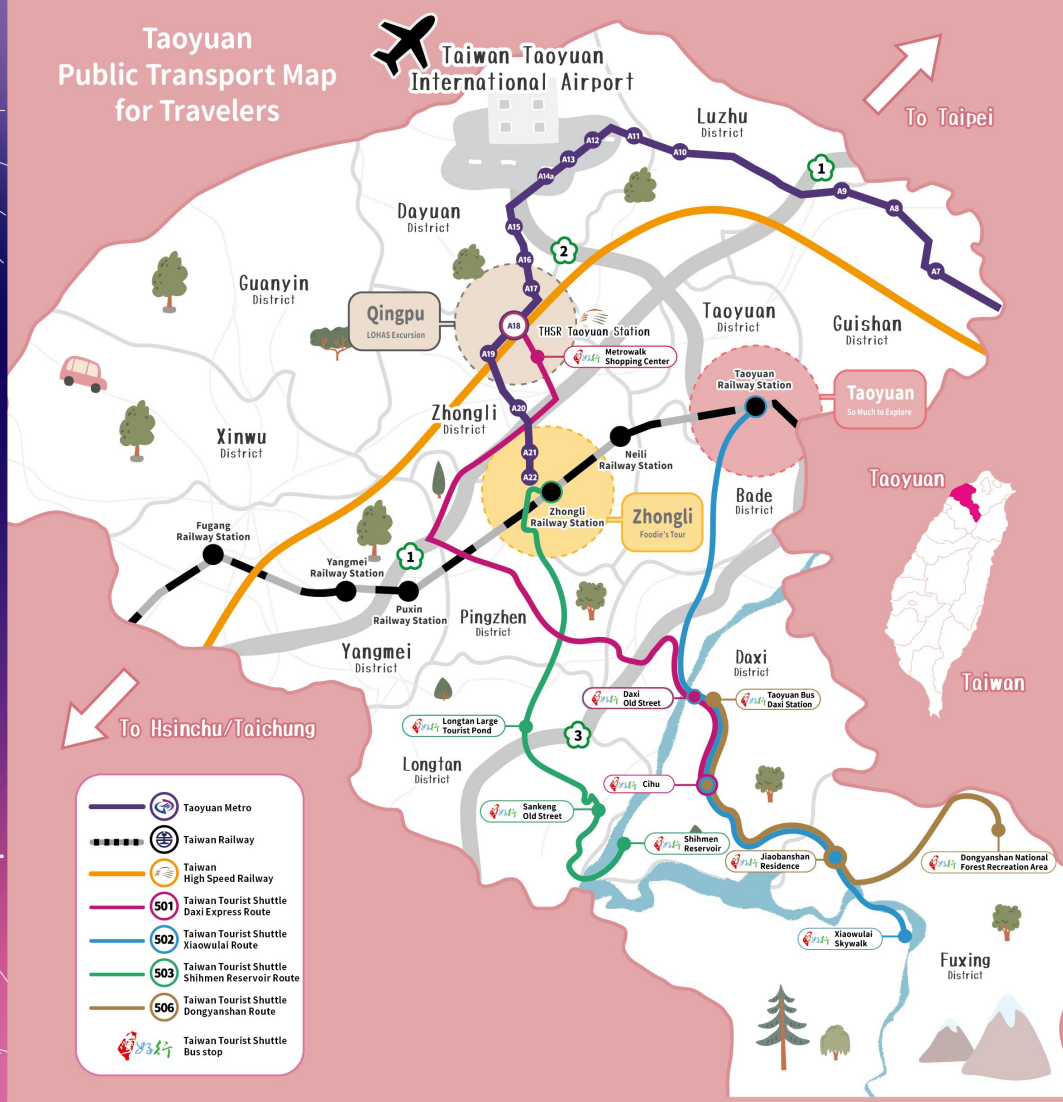

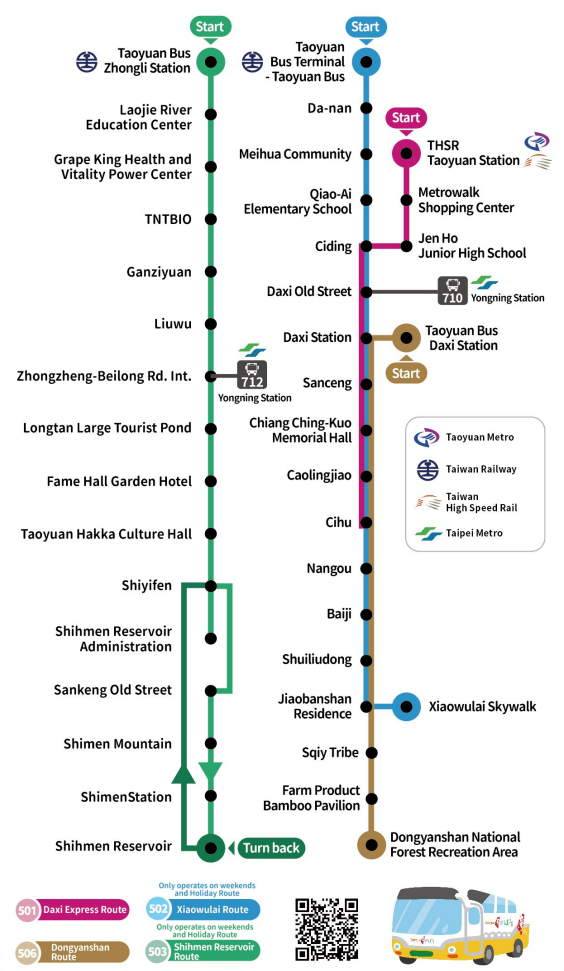

Taiwan Tourist Shuttle Routes

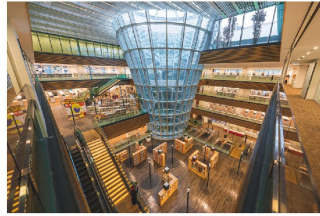

So Much to Explore



5 Taoyuan Arts Plaza



The Taoyuan Main Public Library, inspired by the Tree of Life, along with the Taoyuan Arts Center with its streamlined shape and glass facade are the two biggest draws in Taoyuan's central business district.

4 Hutoushan Park



An abundance of hiking trails wind their way through the unspoiled natural environment. The Environmental Park nearby offers sweeping views of the city lights at night.

3 Tu Di Gong Culture Museum



Tu Di Gong (Land God) is the heavenly equivalent of the village chief. The museum is dedicated to Tu Di Gong's importance in Taoyuan's folk culture.

6 Taoyuan Old Town



The 200-year history of Jing Fu Gong Temple is intertwined with that of the development of Taoyuan. The Japanese era "Damiakou Police Station" and "77 Cultural Streets" are popular tourist sites and offer glimpses into the city's past.

7 Republic of Chocolate



The facilities include cocoa tree planting experiences, learning about chocolate, DIY workshops, as well as a wide variety of flavored chocolates for sale in the gift shop - perfect for family outings.

1 Taoyuan Railway Pavilion



The 90-year-old brick warehouse showcases the development of railways in Taoyuan as well as the city's vision for the future. There is also a simulator providing you with the exciting opportunity to know what it's like to drive the city's MRT.

2 Sha Yang Ye Robot Wonderland



There are seven exhibitions, including dancing and drumming robots as well as robotic gladiator games. There is also a wide range of DIY workshops.

8 Shopping District between the Railway Station and Jinfu Temple

Late-Night Food Mecca

From the department stores in front of the railway station to Jinfu Temple, the road is lined with many street food vendors selling foodstuffs including grilled chicken drumsticks, duck rice and noodles, rice vermicelli with pork intestines, rice noodles with oyster, traditional pudding cake, and more. Taoyuan's Mecca for late night snacks is right behind Jinfu Temple.

9 Taoyuan Tourist Night Market

From oyster omelets, pan-fried dumplings, crispy fried pork ribs, shrimp cakes, steak, herbal tea and ding bian cuo. All kinds of general goods are also available.



5 Taoyuan Arts Plaza

Bazaar of Exotic Cuisine

The variety of food stalls and restaurants serving up Taiwanese, Chinese, Japanese, American, Italian, Korean, Cantonese, Vietnamese, and Indian cuisine offer visitors the chance to go for an old favorite or try something new.

8 Goat World Leisure Farm



In addition to producing goat's milk, the family-oriented farm offers visitors the chance to see and feed capybaras, gophers, sika deer, and goats. There is also a restaurant and rock-climbing area.

7 Renhai Temple



The magnificent main hall of this century-old temple is dedicated to a Mazu statue carved from thousand-year-old agarwood. For nearly two hundred years, this temple has been the spiritual center of the local people.

1 Laojie Creek Trail



The abundance of connected green spaces and parks allows visitors to walk or cycle as they take in the both the untouched natural vistas and the modern city views.

2 Zhongping Shopping District



Zhongping Road in front of Zhongli Railway Station is a pedestrian-only zone that stretches nearly 700m. Shop 'til you drop! You can find everything here—from high fashion and boutique accessories to delicious street food.

3 Zhongli City Story Houses



Zhongping Road Story House, Zhongli Forest Story House, and Zhongli 1941 are all converted Japanese dormitories. The combination of heritage protection with education, arts, and culture has created popular tourist attractions.

4 New Matsu Village



Houses where military dependents once lived are now a creative hub for promoting high-quality lifestyles. Markets, celebrity seminars, and presentations of handpicked goods are held at various times.

6 Zhongli Liuhe Shopping District



The department store and cinema are surrounded by boutiques, restaurants, and cafes, creating a trendy and cosmopolitan vibe. Many of Taoyuan's specialty cafes can be found here.

5 Chung Yuan Cultural And Creative Park



Warehouses that once stored U.S. aid are now a cultural creativity hub for exhibitions, performances, markets, food, and talent incubation.

Foodies will find themselves drawn to Laojie River Station and Xinming Market, which are packed full of vendors selling pies, cold noodles, soy milk breakfasts, Hakka rice dumplings, beef noodle soup, Hakka noodles, pan-fried vegetable buns, and peanut desserts.



9 Zhongli Tourist Night Market

All You Can Eat in Zhongli

The night market stretches for approximately 700m and almost all of the vendors here are established names. Famous delicacies include spicy stinky tofu, crispy pork spare ribs, tofu pudding, sweet potato balls, rice vermicelli soup, salted chicken, and almond tea. On top of food, everything from trendy merchandise to general goods and toys can also be found here. Don't miss this night market if you are visiting Zhongli!

11 Zhongyuan Night Market

1 KIRI International Indigenous Cultural and Creative Park



In addition to hosting markets, exhibitions, DIY workshops, and concerts from time to time, there are also indigenous cuisines, cultural experiences, handicrafts, and boutique shops waiting for you to explore!

2 Hengshan Calligraphy Art Center



The Center's exterior design was inspired by the inkstone and other tools from traditional calligraphy, and holds exhibitions of domestic and international calligraphy artworks from time to time. Creative interactive experiences offer an easy way to experience the beauty of Oriental ink calligraphy.

3 Xpark



This aquarium boasts a two-story main exhibition tank, cute penguins, and hypnotic jellyfish. Immersive audio, lighting, and interactive technology create a wondrous marine experience.

4 Gloria Outlets



The first American-style open-air outlet in Taiwan brings together nearly 300 international boutique brands and popular restaurants from across Taiwan and the world. The great prices and proximity to the airport makes a pre-departure shopping spree very inviting.

9 Taiwan High Speed Rail Museum



The exhibits showcase the history of the railways in Taiwan and around the world. There is even a life-sized high speed rail head car where you can experience what it's like to drive as fast as the wind.

8 Metrowalk Shopping Center



Western and Japanese lifestyle brands, flagship gaming stores, a movie theater, and themed restaurants mean plenty of fun and shopping for both young and old alike!

5 Taoyuan Children's Art Center



The top of the building is reminiscent of a sloping hillside and offers spectacular views. The creative exhibits will inspire the imaginations of all children.

6 Chintan Park



The main attraction is the cable-stayed bridge with two towers spanning the pond. The waterside slope, scenic platform, and expansive green space are perfect for family outings.

7 Taoyuan Baseball Stadium and Global Mall A19



There is no better place to experience the charged atmosphere of "Rakuten's Home Turf". The nearby Global Mall features a cinema as well as exciting activities such as skiing and rock-climbing.
